Call to Order

Mr. Ben Williams called the 2017-2018 LSC Meeting to order at 5:20pm.

The meeting agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

- Dr. McManus presented a copy of the school budget which detailed to date expenditures.
- Dr. McManus presented the internal accounts balance sheets and cash disbursements for the following months:
 - 10.18 \$156,603.37-Balance
 11.18 \$137,608.80-Balance
 12.18 \$139,512.19-Balance
 \$26,789.37-Disbursements
 \$34,903.81-Disbursements
 \$07,077.61-Disbursements
- Dr. McManus informed the council that, after MOY NWEA testing, STEM will be expanding its afterschool program to cover students whose NWEA Math and Reading scores are below the 69th percentile.
- Dr. McManus informed the council of the following school-wide testing dates:
 - o Winter NWEA (12.12.17-01.24.18)
 - o PARCC (03.05.18-03.23.18)
 - o Illinois Science Assessment-5th & 8th Grades (04.16.18-04.27.18)
 - o Spring NWEA (05.15.18-06.15.18)

- Dr. McManus addressed the decrease in student attendance during the months of December and January due to severe cases of the flu. She emailed parents a onepager regarding best practices for dealing with this virus.
- Dr. McManus discussed the sale of STEM paraphernalia. For the winter months parents were able to purchase STEM Scarves and Scullies. This was not a fundraiser, it was just a way to show STEM Pride. Additional paraphernalia will be forthcoming.
- Dr. McManus addressed the fact that the school is in need of new Smart Boards, because the current Smart Boards are 7+ years old and need to be upgraded. STEM will be transitioning from the actual Smart Board model to a flat panel tv model. Each Smart Board costs approximately \$4500. FOS will be working with the school to raise funds for the new Smart Boards.
- Dr. McManus spoke with Kevin McGuire regarding parent concern with CPS transportation at the beginning of the school year. She also inquired about the seemingly excessive fees bus companies charge for field trips. Mr. McGuire was aware of the issues and acknowledged her concerns. He also recommended that STEM have all students bussing applications submitted by early August. This will assist with creating bus routes in a timely fashion. With regard to the cost for field trips, Mr. McGuire stated that individual bus companies determine pricing for field trip.
- Dr. McManus announced that the application process for the 2018-2020 LSC is underway. The deadline for applications is Friday, March 2nd at 3pm.

- CIWP: A new CIWP process is being implemented by CPS. Principals are tentatively scheduled to receive training on this process in January or February. Once the training takes place, Dr. McManus will set dates with the staff to complete the actual 2018-2020 CIWP.
